The first Kamov's serial helicopter, the Ka-15 became the main shipborn machine of the Soviet Navy.



7252 Kamov Ka-18

The Ka-18 became the first pure civilian helicopter in the USSR and featured a colorful painting scheme.



7245 Kamov Ka-31

Developed as a shipborn AEWACS helicopter, the Ka-31 has a large ventral radar antenna.



7250 Mil Mi-1MU

The first anti-tank helicopter in Soviet Army inventory, the Mi-1MU helped to develop tactics.



7256 Kamov Ka-15M

The Ka-15M succeeded in production the Ka-15 and featured a ventral fin and other improvements.



7240 Kamov Ka-26

Kamov Ka-26 light utility helicopter was widely operated in Eastern European countries.



7249 Kamov Ka-32

Sharing many subassemblies with naval Ka-27, the Ka-32 is one of the most potent civilian airlifters.



7241 Yakovlev Yak-2

Yakovlev Yak-2 was in serial production for a short period and took part in the initial stage of WW II.



7246 Shevchenko IS-1

The unique IS-1 (Iosif Stalin) bi/monoplane featured a foldable lower wing that could be retracted in flight.



7251 Yakovlev UT-2

The UT-2 was developed as an initial trainer aircraft. Many VVS pilots made their first flight in the UT-2.



7219 Polikarpov I-153

Borovkov & Florov I-207 was yet another attempt to develop a high-speed biplane.



7235 Yakovlev Yak-4

The Yak-4 was a light and speedy tactical bomber built mainly of wood and saw a lot of front-line service.



7276 Shevchenko IS-2

This biplane/monoplane convertible fighter became the second actually flown prototype in IS program.




7262 Tomashevich «Pegasus»

Developed in 1942 as airborne tank destroyer «Pegasus» was not adopted for serial production.



7230 Tikhonravov I-302P

This WW II rocket fighter was test flown, but the serial production was canceled.





7233 Yak-130

The main competitor of the MiG-AT, Yakovlev Yak-130 is proposed to Russian Air Force as an advanced trainer.



7264 La-250

The last Lavochkin's manned aircraft the La-250 could become a good interceptor, but lost to the Tu-128.



7263 Su-15TM

Sleepless guard of the sky, the Su-15TM became world famous after incident with Korean Boeing-747.



7244 Yak-28P

Though it was never adopted for service, Yakovlev Yak-28P became the standard PVO interceptor.



7239 MiG-AT

Mikoyan MiG-AT is some 1,5 t lighter than Yakovlev Yak-130 and features more conventional design.

The KASKR-1 autogiro made its maiden flight in 1929 and shared the fuselage assembly with the U-1 biplane.



7261 SPAD S.A.4

After replacement of the Ron-9C engine by more powerful Ron-9J the aircraft was named SPAD S.A.4.



7259 AVRO-504K

A famous WW I aircraft — the AVRO-504K is faithfully reproduced in this kit.

The rocket launcher version of the Bf.109.




3503 UAZ-469VAI

Armed with 4 30-mm guns and 8 missile tubes, the 2S6 is the best mobile AA-system today.




7201 VolksWagen type 60 Ferdinand Porsche developed a famous car that was widely used by Wehrmacht.


