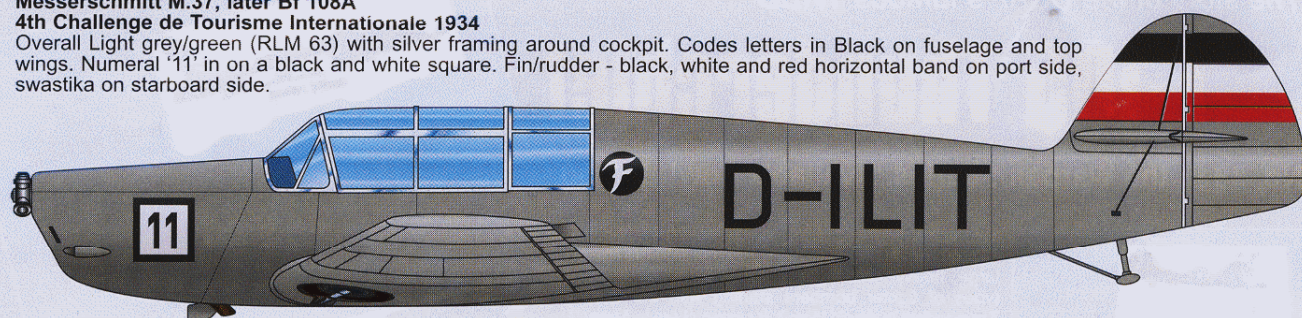

4th Challenge de Tourisme Internationale 1934

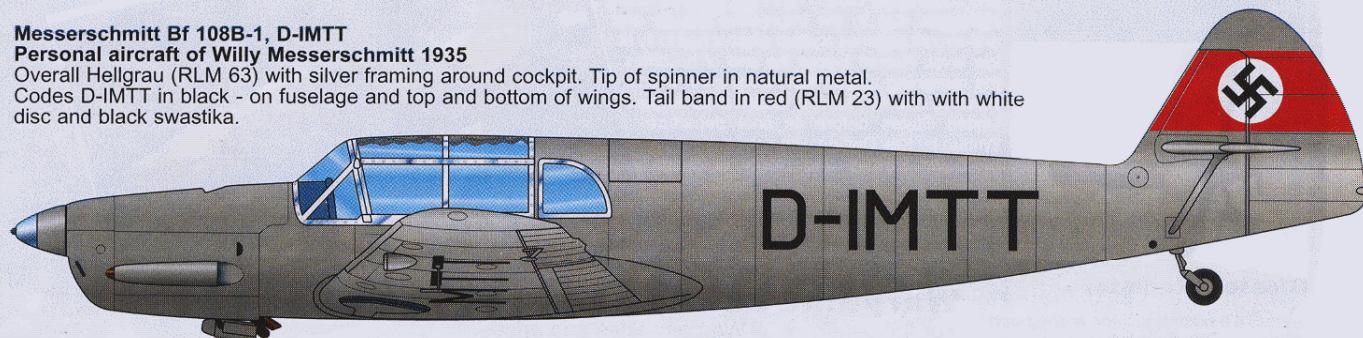
Overall Light grey/green (RLM 63) with silver framing around cockpit. Codes letters in Black on fuselage and top wings. Numeral '11' in on a black and white square. Fin/rudder - black, white and red horizontal band on port side, swastika on starboard side.



Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, D-IMTT

Personal aircraft of Willy Messerschmitt 1935

Overall Hellgrau (RLM 63) with silver framing around cockpit. Tip of spinner in natural metal. Codes D-IMTT in black - on fuselage and top and bottom of wings. Tail band in red (RLM 23) with with white disc and black swastika.



Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, D-1010, 1935

Overall Creme (RLM 05) with black nose with cheat line to tail strut. Silver framing around cockpit. Spinner in natural metal.

Codes, D-1010, in black on fuselage top and bottom of wings
Tail band in red (RLM 23) with with white disc and black swastika.



Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, D-IONO

Demonstration Flights, Rio de Janeiro, 1936

Overall Dark Blue (RLM 24) with silver framing around cockpit.
Codes, D-IONO, in Cream (RLM 05) on fuselage and top of wings.
Tail band in red (RLM 23) with white disc and black swastika.



Messerschmitt BF108c-1

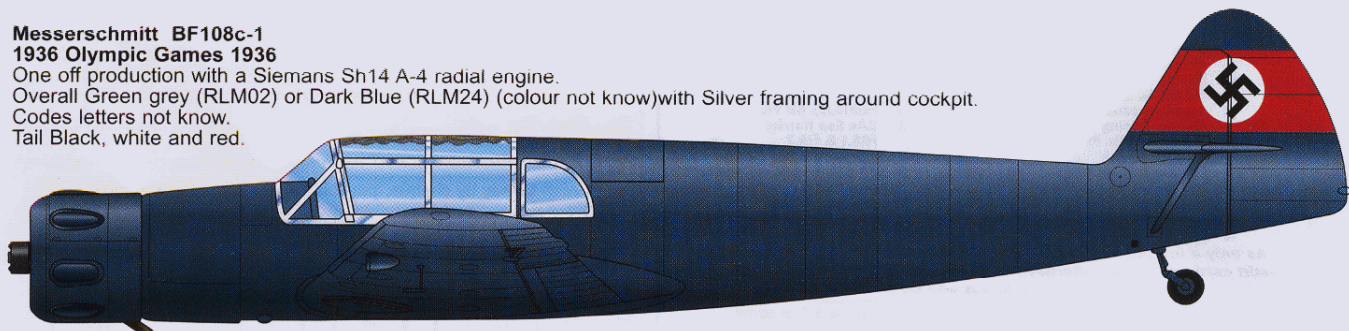
1936 Olympic Games 1936

One off production with a Siemens Sh14 A-4 radial engine.

Overall Green grey (RLM02) or Dark Blue (RLM24) (colour not know)with Silver framing around cockpit.

Codes letters not know.

Tail Black, white and red.



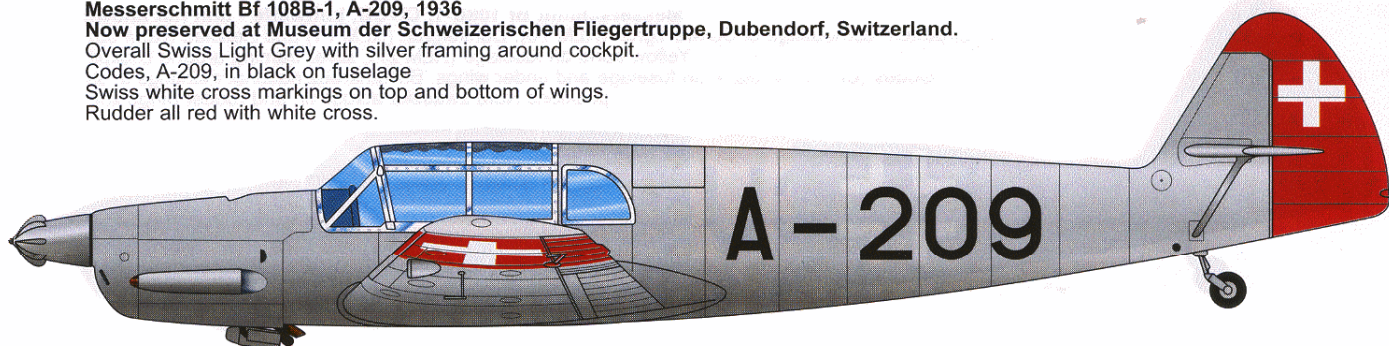

Overall Swiss Light Grey with silver framing around cockpit.

Codes, A-209, in black on fuselage

Swiss white cross markings on top and bottom of wings.

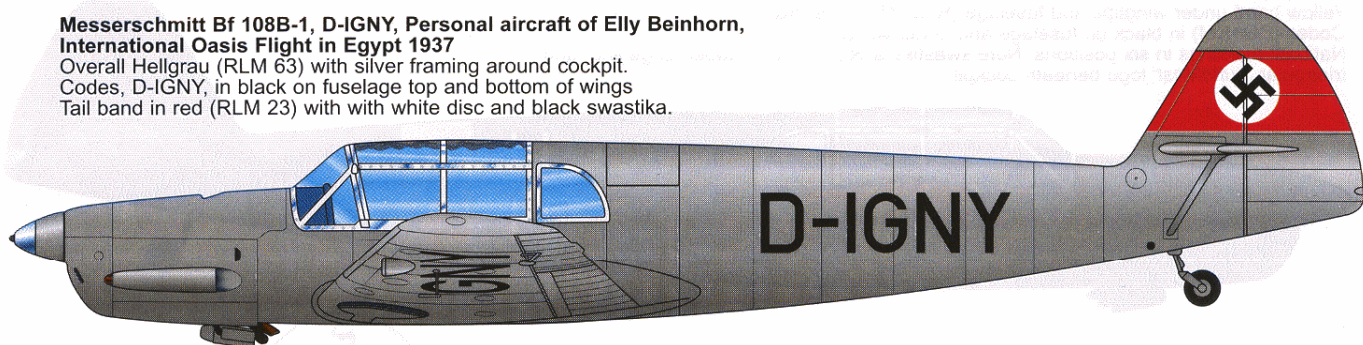
Rudder all red with white cross.

**Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, D-IGNY, Personal aircraft of Elly Beinhorn, International Oasis Flight in Egypt 1937**

Overall Hellgrau (RLM 63) with silver framing around cockpit.

Codes, D-IGNY, in black on fuselage top and bottom of wings

Tail band in red (RLM 23) with with white disc and black swastika.

**Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, D-IPLO, used in the SevilleSternflug (Spain) 1938**

Overall Dark Blue (RLM 24) with silver framing around cockpit.

Codes, (D-IPLO, in Cream (RLM 05) on fuselage.

Tail band in red (RLM 23) with white disc and black swastika.

**Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1 G.352 1938-42, unknown Hungarian Air Force Training Unit**

Overall dark blue. Yellow band on fuselage; silver framing around cockpit.

White codes on fuselage. Hungarian national chevron markings on rudder and wings in red, white and green.

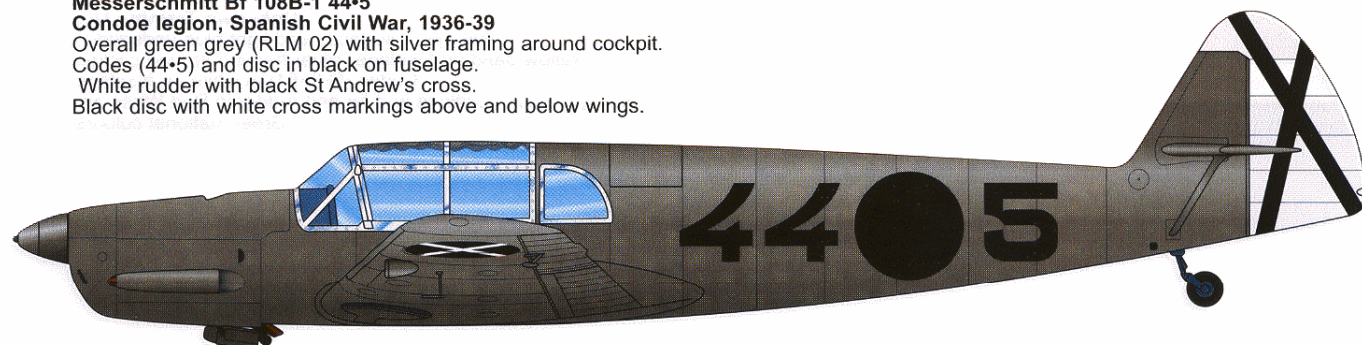
**Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1 44-5****Condor legion, Spanish Civil War, 1936-39**

Overall green grey (RLM 02) with silver framing around cockpit.

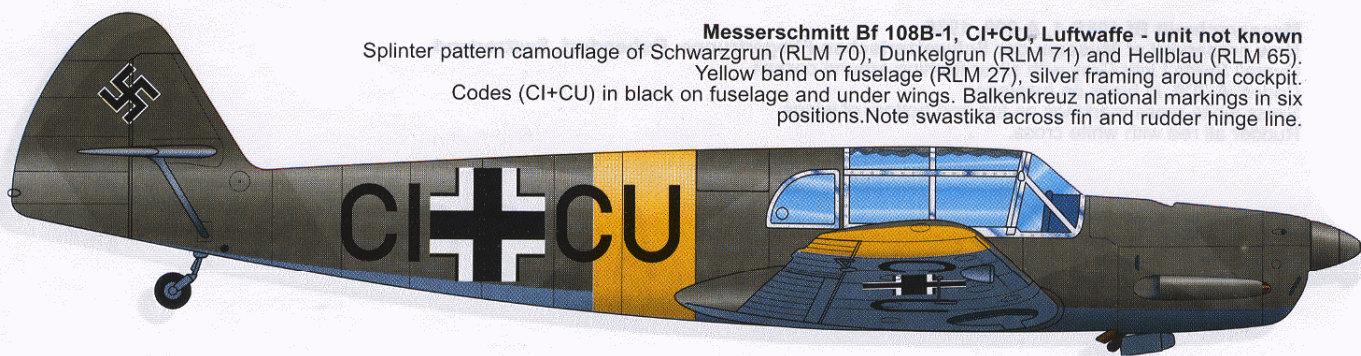
Codes (44-5) and disc in black on fuselage.

White rudder with black St Andrew's cross.

Black disc with white cross markings above and below wings.

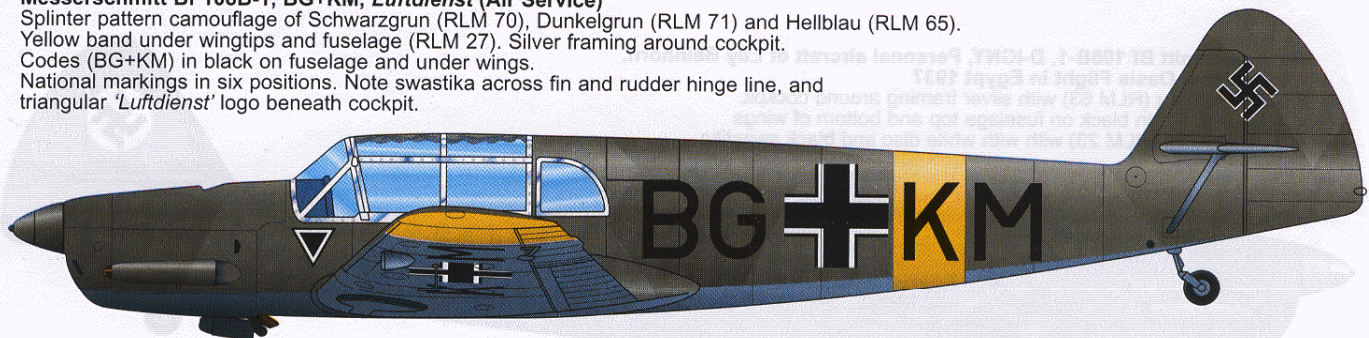


Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, CI+CU, Luftwaffe - unit not known

Splinter pattern camouflage of Schwarzgrün (RLM 70), Dunkelgrün (RLM 71) and Hellblau (RLM 65). Yellow band on fuselage (RLM 27), silver framing around cockpit. Codes (CI+CU) in black on fuselage and under wings. Balkenkreuz national markings in six positions. Note swastika across fin and rudder hinge line.

Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, BG+KM, Luftdienst (Air Service)

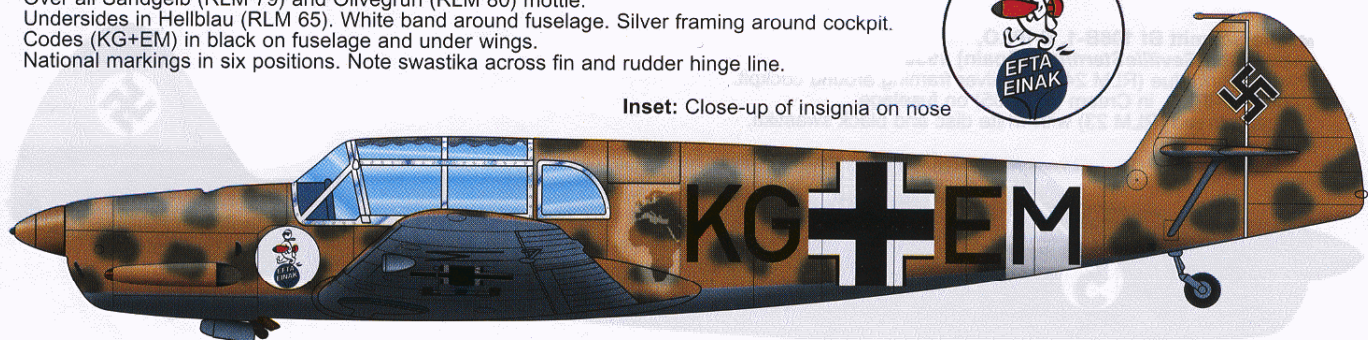
Splinter pattern camouflage of Schwarzgrün (RLM 70), Dunkelgrün (RLM 71) and Hellblau (RLM 65). Yellow band under wingtips and fuselage (RLM 27). Silver framing around cockpit. Codes (BG+KM) in black on fuselage and under wings. National markings in six positions. Note swastika across fin and rudder hinge line, and triangular 'Luftdienst' logo beneath cockpit.



Messerschmitt Bf 108B-2, KG+EM, Luftwaffe, unit not known, North Africa, 1941-42

Over all Sandgelb (RLM 79) and Olivegrün (RLM 80) mottle. Undersides in Hellblau (RLM 65). White band around fuselage. Silver framing around cockpit. Codes (KG+EM) in black on fuselage and under wings. National markings in six positions. Note swastika across fin and rudder hinge line.

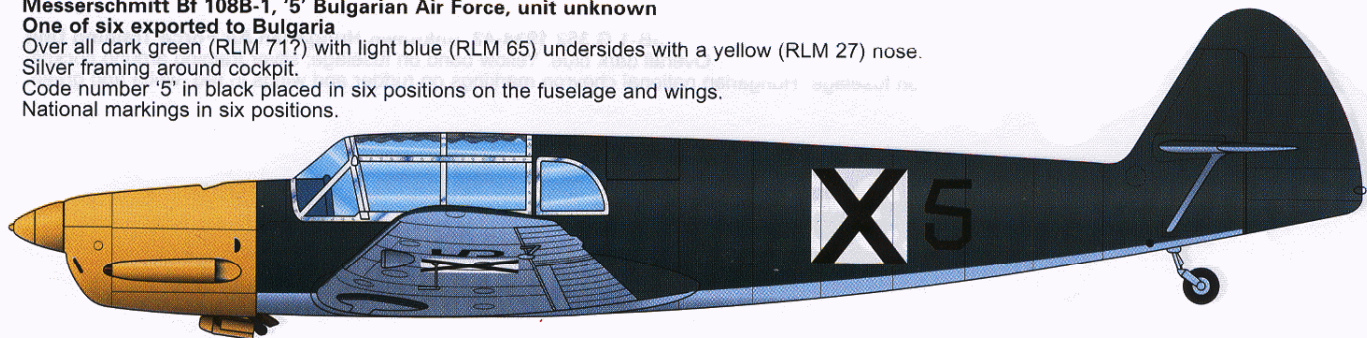
Inset: Close-up of insignia on nose



Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, '5' Bulgarian Air Force, unit unknown

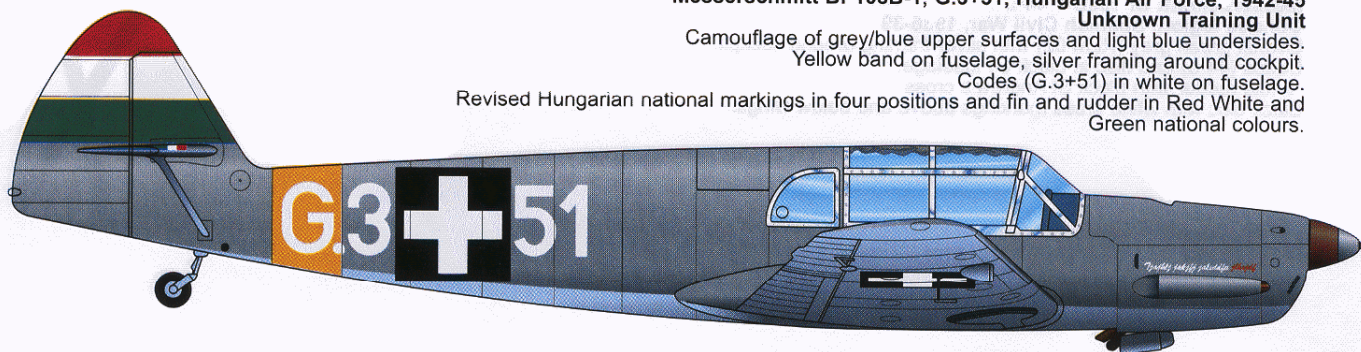
One of six exported to Bulgaria

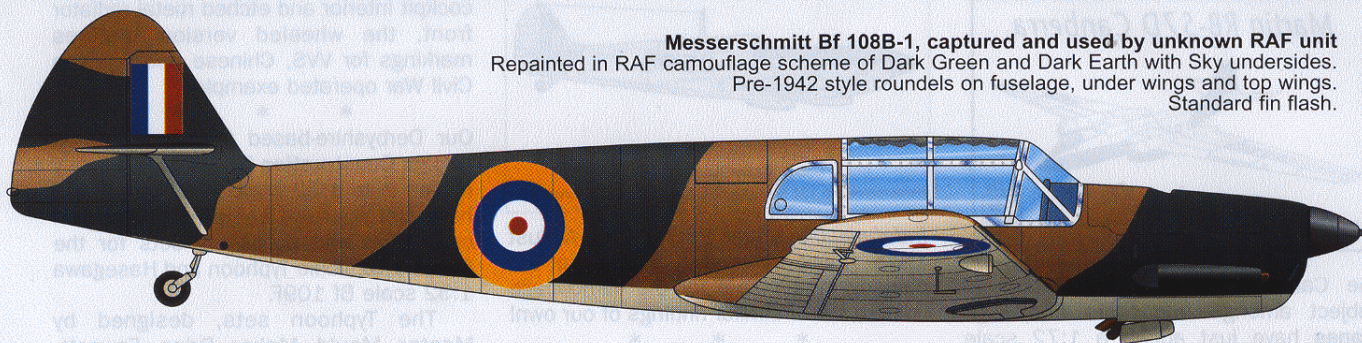
Over all dark green (RLM 71?) with light blue (RLM 65) undersides with a yellow (RLM 27) nose. Silver framing around cockpit. Code number '5' in black placed in six positions on the fuselage and wings. National markings in six positions.



Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, G.3+51, Hungarian Air Force, 1942-45
Unknown Training Unit

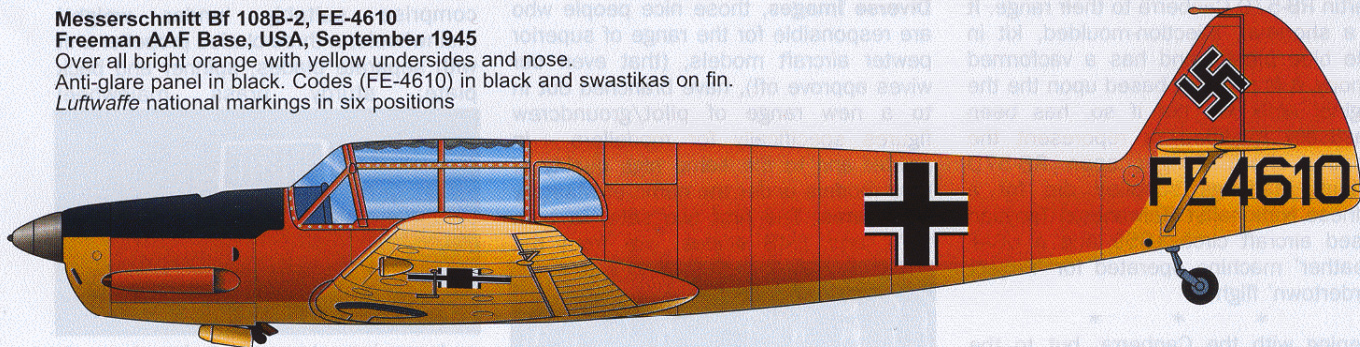
Camouflage of grey/blue upper surfaces and light blue undersides. Yellow band on fuselage, silver framing around cockpit. Codes (G.3+51) in white on fuselage. Revised Hungarian national markings in four positions and fin and rudder in Red White and Green national colours.



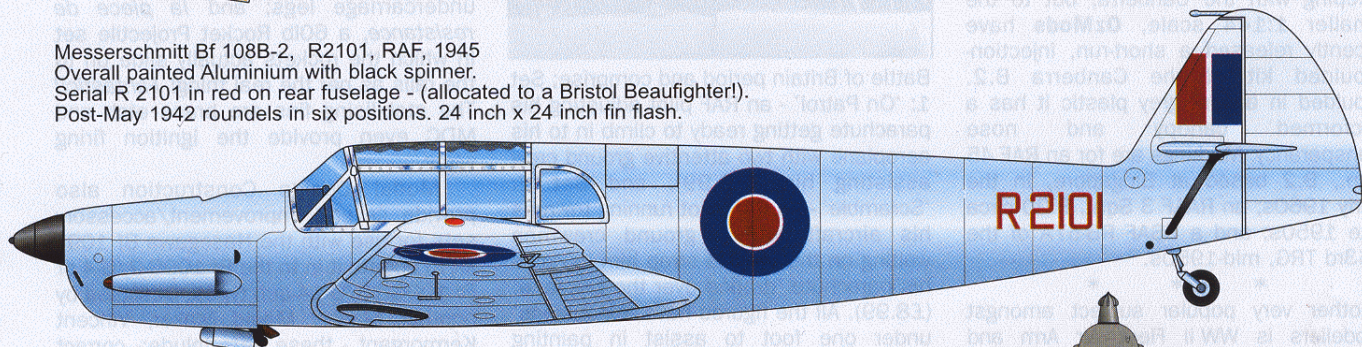


Messerschmitt Bf 108B-1, captured and used by unknown RAF unit
Repainted in RAF camouflage scheme of Dark Green and Dark Earth with Sky undersides.
Pre-1942 style roundels on fuselage, under wings and top wings.
Standard fin flash.

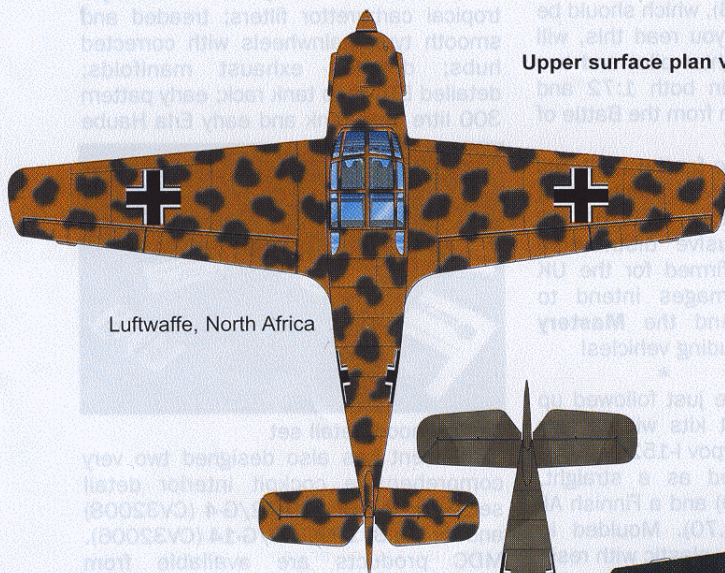
Messerschmitt Bf 108B-2, FE-4610
Freeman AAF Base, USA, September 1945
Over all bright orange with yellow undersides and nose.
Anti-glare panel in black. Codes (FE-4610) in black and swastikas on fin.
Luftwaffe national markings in six positions



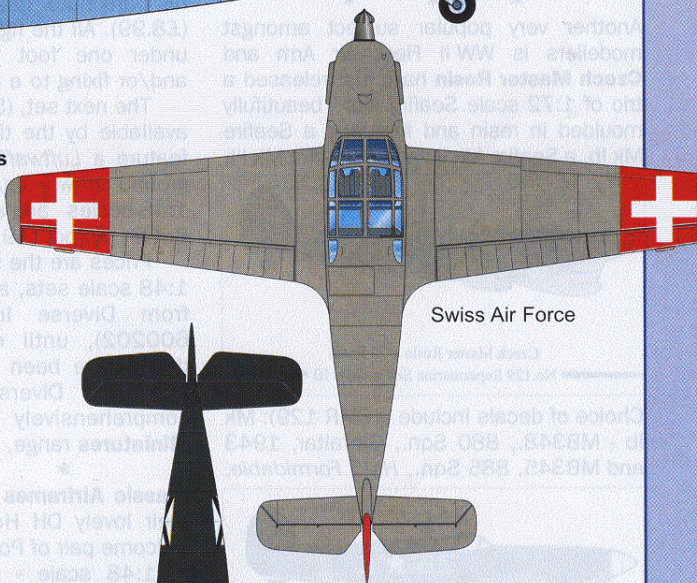
Messerschmitt Bf 108B-2, R2101, RAF, 1945
Overall painted Aluminium with black spinner.
Serial R 2101 in red on rear fuselage - (allocated to a Bristol Beaufighter!).
Post-May 1942 roundels in six positions. 24 inch x 24 inch fin flash.
